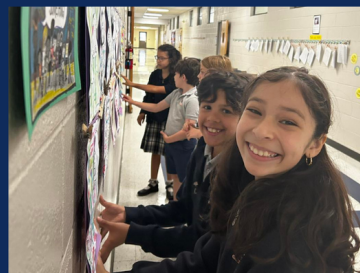

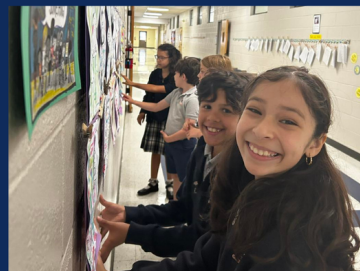

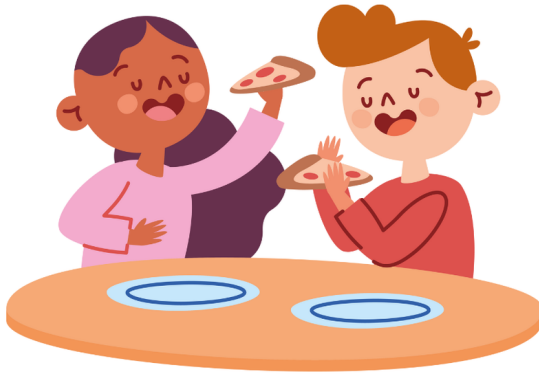
**On Thursday, please select sauce for wings. Also, Thursday there are no meals, please be sure to order cookie, chips, fruit if you would like it added.**

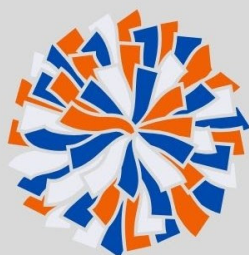

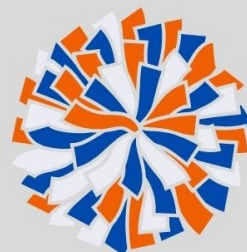
