## Altar Server Expectations

1. Servers must be in baptized in the Catholic Church and must have received First Eucharist
2. Servers must be in 5<sup>th</sup> grade or older
3. Servers must arrive at least 15 minutes before Mass begins
4. Weekend schedules are written 2 months at a time. It is the server's responsibility to know his/her schedule.
5. Servers are responsible for arranging a substitute when needed if they are not able to serve for any reason.
6. Servers are available to serve at both weekend and school day masses (as available).
