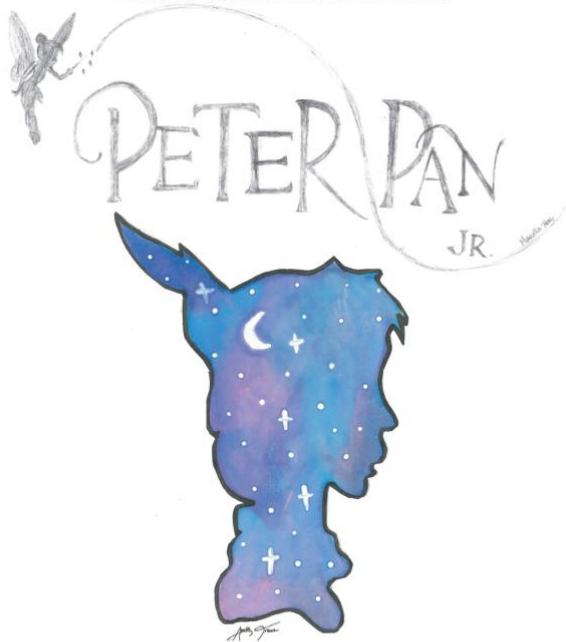

DIRECTOR'S NOTE!

Children imagine easily. They dream, they pretend, they tell stories, and they believe that anything is possible. A bedroom can become a pirate ship. A game can become a quest. A simple thought can become an entire world. Childhood is filled with wonder, and with the kind of imagination that allows us to see more than what is right in front of us.
