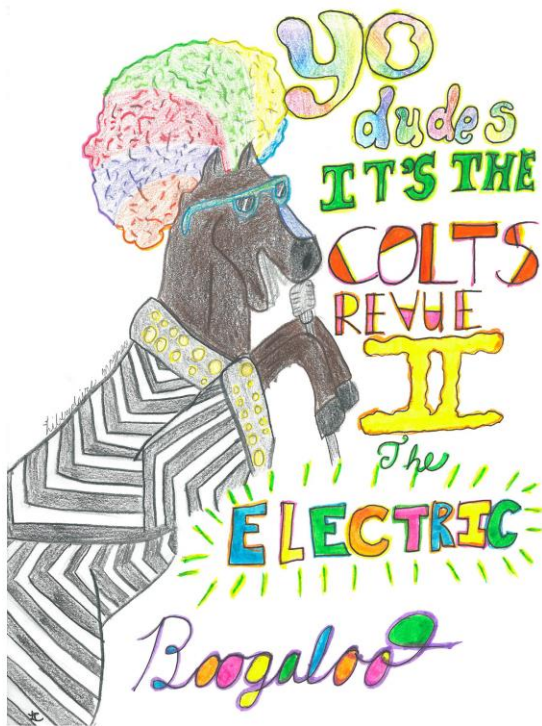

As you know, we had a change in the school's administration this year, and I'm so happy to report that Ms. Reichart and Mr. Harris were immediately "two feet in" for continuing to bring the arts to these children. They have gone above and beyond in their support, and I am so thankful. And of course I am so grateful for everything the parents do. They are the backbone of this whole operation, and I want to thank them for the sacrifices they make to bring the kids to rehearsal, buy all the tickets, t-shirts, and program ads, and lend their talents to the production. Costumes have been altered, catering food has been provided, and heavy sets have been carried by our intrepid cast parents (and teachers, and relatives, and people that don't have a child in the show, but just want to help!). It is my fervent hope that we can all spend these performance dates enjoying the fruits of our labors, starting with the incredible efforts these kids have made to put on a great performance.

As you will hear in a few minutes, we've got some "Magic To Do" tonight. Let's all enjoy the talents of these children, during this fleeting moment when they're young, and thank God for this two hours of fun we get to share.

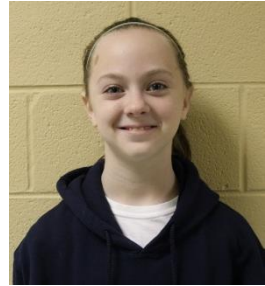

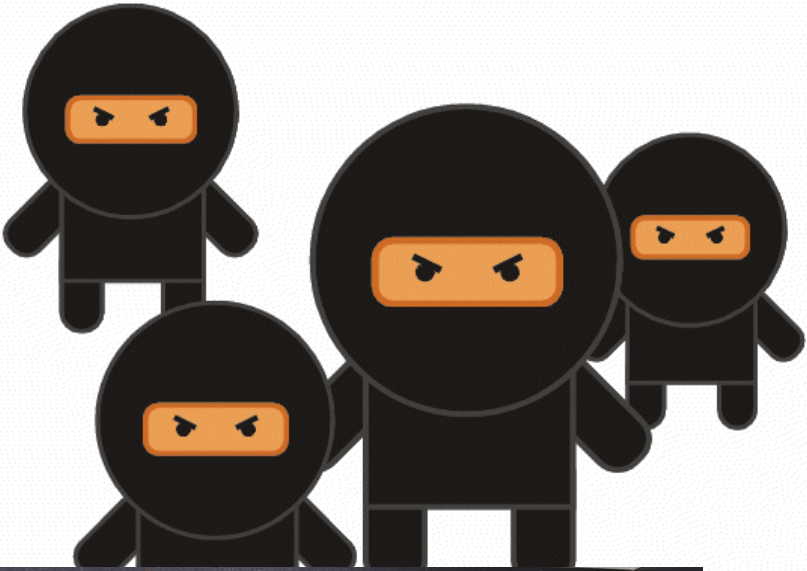
