Next, your scholar will work in **SECOND grade IXL** -- not third grade, until he or she reaches a **Smartscore of at least 80**. If you'd like him or her to work beyond that, go for it! The more practice, the better. Feel free to have him/her work in any other 2nd grade IXL skills or content areas in which you feel he/she needs extra practice.

If your Scholar has already completed these sections, please have them redo them for the extra practice. If it's not completed over the summer, it won't show up on my report
